

The McCully Heritage Project is a private non-profit organization, which provides its facilities for public use. Please help us maintain our facilities by observing the following:

- ◆ Camp only in designated areas (**DO NOT** camp by the ponds without special permission).
- ◆ Campfires are allowed, but please keep the fires small and safe (no bonfires please!).
- ◆ Firewood is available for use at camp sites (please leave an extra \$5 donation for use of firewood). Please **DO NOT** cut or gather your own firewood from the forest.
- ◆ The McCully Heritage Project is a family oriented facility, please refrain from loud music and/or parties and be courteous to other visitors.
- ◆ Please place your garbage in the dumpster by the barn. Please keep your campsite clean and remove trash upon departure.
- ◆ Restrooms are available in the white building next to the barn.
- ◆ Vehicles are allowed in parking areas and the campsite areas only. Please do not drive to the pond without permission. If possible, please park your vehicle in the parking lot after unloading.

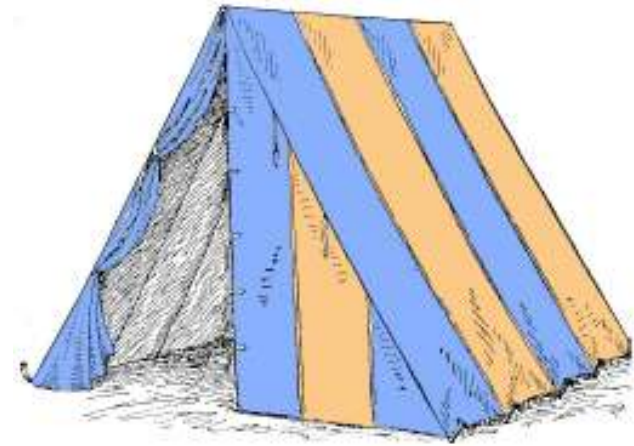

### What you will find at the McCully Heritage Project:

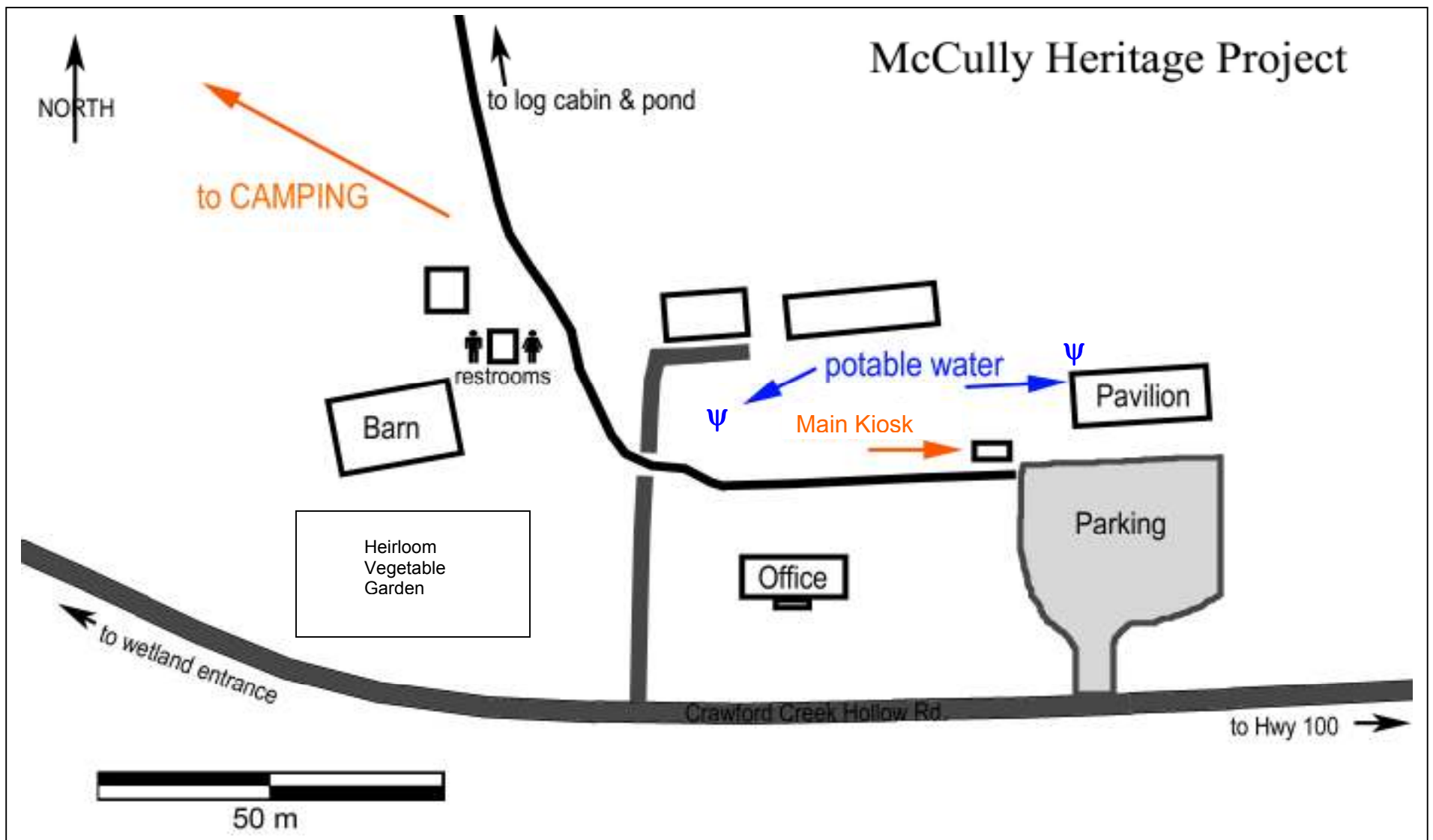
- 15 miles of hiking and horseback trails

- ◆ **Camp sites are available northwest of the barn – see map.** ◆
- ◆ **Please do not camp by the pond without prior permission.** ◆
- ◆ **A donation of \$7.50 is requested per night per family - use donation envelope and leave in donation box – Please include your name, address, phone & email.** ◆
- ◆ **Hike-in camping is also allowed with prior arrangements.** ◆



- ◆ There are 3 tent camping sites available northwest of the red barn. ◆
- ◆ You may drive your vehicle to the camping area to unload, but we ask that you leave your vehicle in the parking lot if possible after unloading. ◆
- ◆ Potable water is available from two pumps – one at the northwest corner of the pavilion and one in the yard (next to the big clump of ornamental grass). ◆
- ◆ Please leave a donation for \$7.50 per night in a donation envelope with your name, address, etc. Deposit in red box. ◆
